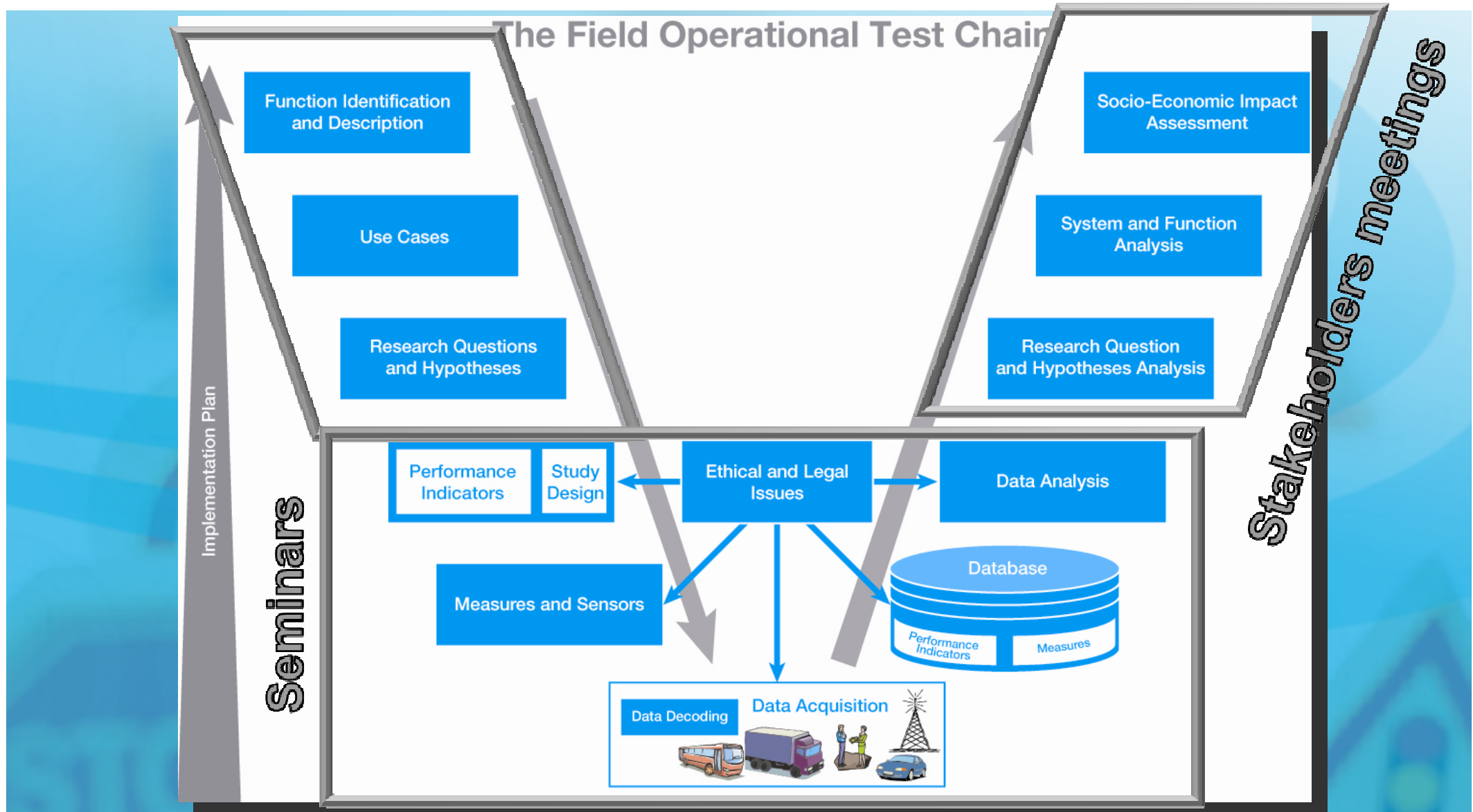


Focus on FOT actors to harmonise the implementation of FOTs in Europe
